DELIBERATIVE DEMOCRACY (PILOT/SCOPING)

Snapshot

This Scoping Study outlines what Deliberative Democracy (DD) is and is not, describes global initiatives that have applied DD principles to a greater and less degree, assesses their success, and recommends how the CRC might best apply DD to meet its goals

Outcome

The report recommends the importance of establishing ways for members of the community to use their skills, knowledge and viewpoints to resolve issues and develop options which may then influence decisions to be made in their community by policy makers. The scoping study would identify opportunities for deliberative democracy research within the CRC over the next 3 - 5 years. This scoping study will examine the potential links between the 3 Programs, in particular 2 and 3; and ways this methodology could be used to create synergies between the actors, the processes and the outcomes.
